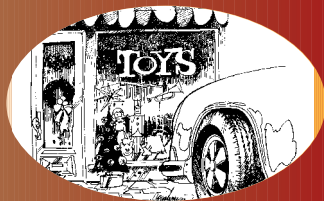

As you make plans to visit Hershey for the 2005 Porsche Parade from 25 June–3 July 2005, the first weekend promises innovations and excitement for both Parade registrants and day trippers.

On Saturday, 25 June, the first ever National Literature and Parts Swap Meet will be held on the expansive parking lots behind the Hershey Amusement Park outdoor stadium. Brought to you by Central Penn Region, the same folks who do Hershey in the spring, this will be a reprise of that swap meet with a national flavor for vendors and buyers alike. East Coasters know Hershey in April is huge. A National Swap Meet at the Parade on this day will be a great opportunity for Porsche lovers across the country to experience the great automobilia traditions of Hershey and Carlisle- only with a Porsche flavor!

to attend the Parade car show, held in conjunction with the Parade Concours d'Elegance and historic car display at the scenic Hotel Hershey Golf Course.

The car show, however, is totally low key, featuring a tongue-in-cheek People's Choice Voting for a unique set of awards. No judges, no q-tips, just fun. JUST THE FACTS

Registration Information

This will be the first Parade to conduct electronic registration. Opening day for registration will be Tuesday, January 18, 2005. Online registration will be available at 8 a.m. eastern time. There is no need to log on at 8 am; all registrations until midnight eastern time will have an "equivalent post-mark" time.

If you prefer to pay by check or money order, include only one registration per envelope and mail along with payment of the appropriate registration fee to: Porsche Parade 2005 P.O.Box 5900 Springfield, VA 22150.

The Technical Details

The registration fee for the 50th Parade is \$150. This fee covers one car, the entrant and the co-entrant. The registration fee is required even if you do not enter a competitive event. If you bring an extra participant, a child of the entrant/co-entrant, under age 18 they will pay additional \$30 family guest fee and must comply with the requirements of the Junior Participant Program. The fee for children under 25 is also \$30; other immediate family members need to pay a full registration fee of \$150.

Selection of Entrants

Registrations will be accepted based on postmarks and date (not the time) the online registration is submitted. Registrations with postmarks prior to January 18, 2005, won't be accepted.

Eligibility

PCA members of any class of membership may register for the 50th Porsche Parade. All entrants must be members in good standing at the time of the application and the Parade.

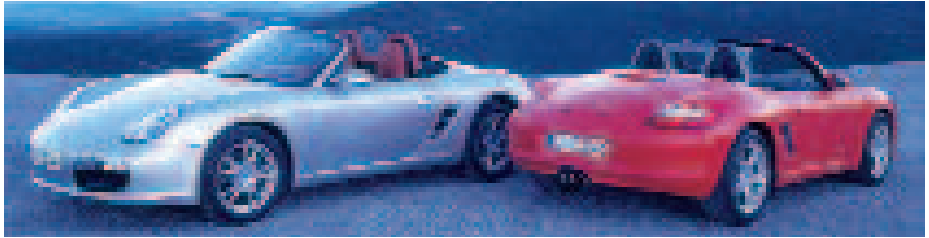

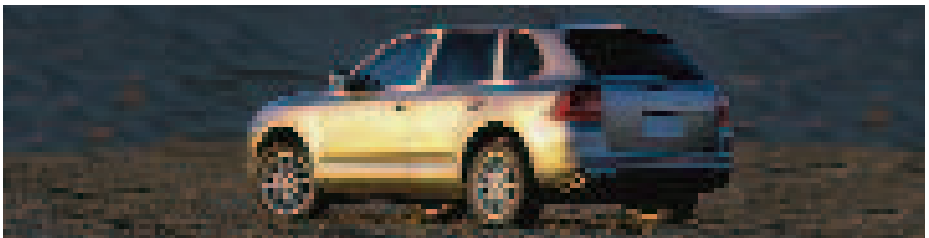
